



# Moving Checklist



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- 1. COLLECT OR PURCHASE MOVING SUPPLIES** including boxes, packing tape, moving blankets, mattress covers, and bubble wrap.
  - 2. LABEL BOXES** with different coloured labels for each room to easily decipher which box goes where when you get to your new home.
  - 3. CALL TO RENT A MOVING BOX** and arrange to have it delivered prior to your moving date so you can pack at your own pace.
  - 4. BOOK MOVERS TO HELP** with the heavier items that you know you can't move on your own.
  - 5. PACK ANY ITEMS YOU KNOW YOU HAVEN'T USED** in years in separate boxes to drop off at a local donation bin.
  - 6. BOOK JUNK REMOVAL SERVICES** to discard large items that are broken or no longer useful.
  - 7. NOTIFY UTILITIES**, cable and phone companies, alarm and security companies, and any other service providers of your moving date.
  - 8. CALL YOUR INSURANCE COMPANY** to set up insurance for your new home. You can also prearrange to cancel your old policy on your moving day.
  - 9. FIND SOMEONE TO WATCH YOUR PET(S)** ahead of time so you don't have to worry about taking care of them during your busy day.
  - 10. CONSIDER PURCHASING A MAIL FORWARDING SERVICE** with Canada Post to avoid having any mail delivered to your old address.
  - 11. NOTIFY YOUR BANK** and credit cards of your address change after moving.
  - 12. VISIT SERVICE ONTARIO** to update your personal information on your Driver's License (within 6 days) and Health Card (within 30 days) after moving.
